



SKI WAX TAKE BACK PROGRAM

Help protect Park City well water and wastewater

Perfluoroalkyl and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS), also known as forever chemicals, have been detected in local groundwater wells and wastewater

- Fluorocarbon ski wax is likely responsible for low-level PFAS contamination
- Banned in advance of the 2022 Winter Olympics
- Goal to stop continued environmental impacts
- Summer 2022 EPA issued updated Drinking Water Health Advisories, regulations pending

- Requesting local residents, visitors, waxers, and ski shops turn in fluorinated ski wax
- Accepting fluorinated waxes: predominantly Nordic and Downhill ski race waxes
- Waxes will be accepted at Recycle Utah near the office door by other hard to recycle items like batteries, light bulbs and ink cartridges
- Wax can be dropped off at Recycle Utah 24/7 through April 15, 2023
