The applicant has filed a Line Extension Agreement to extend wastewater main lines into a private mixed-use development within the Park City Business Center. The proposed project will be served by a short gravity sewer system, which will connect to gravity mainline in Forestdale Road. The developer intends to re-plat at some point in the future.

Staff recommends approval.
